**CHARGE**

To recognize those individuals who make outstanding contributions serving the youth of Maine and for outstanding contributions to education and/or to the general welfare of Maine youth.

**QUALIFICATION/CRITERION FOR SELECTION**

Outstanding contributor to education and/or to the general welfare of Maine youth.

**AWARD**

Recognition by the Maine Principals' Association.

**ELIGIBILITY**

1. Must be a resident of Maine and at least 21 years of age.
2. Must not be a member of the MPA.
3. May not be recognized for service for which they are paid.

**SELECTION PROCEDURE**

1. Any MPA member may nominate any individual in the state.
2. Nominations are to be submitted to the Maine Principals' Association. The nomination package should contain:
  - a. The completed nomination form and
  - b. Three statements of support from professional colleagues, personal references, or community members.
3. The selection of an individual who has made an "outstanding contribution serving youth" will be made by the MPA Staff. Two individuals will be selected to receive the 2017 Adults in Service to Maine Youth Award.

**DEADLINE**

December 16, 2016 – Completed nomination package due at MPA office.

**INFORMATION**

Presentation of this award will be made at the MPA Spring Conference banquet on April 27, 2017. Two recipients will be honored. Each recipient will receive an appropriate plaque and media recognition.

Nominees for this award who are not selected will remain in the pool of nominees for two years beyond the year of nomination.
